Prep for HLC assessment: Why didn't we use the data from the Jr. comps? How will we fix that going forward? What is our plan?

Overview by Pat Walsh. Perceptions about what the committee might ask. Brad King spoke to his position of longevity and the lack of motivation for students to take the test. Results and alignment were not found to be strong with gen ed outcomes.

Need an assessment discussion with CM&F. Make sure everyone is all on board with the goal of the instrument. What are we testing? Are we teaching to the test? Or testing what we actually teach? Can we align the instruments with course syllabus?

What evidence can we request from departments? Give strong leadership but not authoritative. Send a formal proposal that lists formal learning outcomes and syllabi.

Approach to current CM&F instrument wasn't vetted well. Doesn't reflect a well thought out process.

More than aspirational. Using FOE process to build on the assessment plan.

HLC might ask about the multiple gen eds across schools. Rationale needs to be clear.
