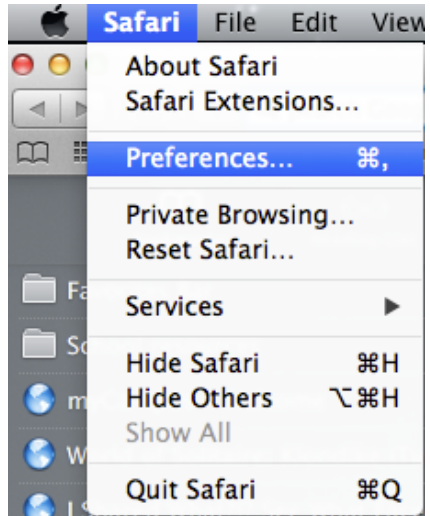


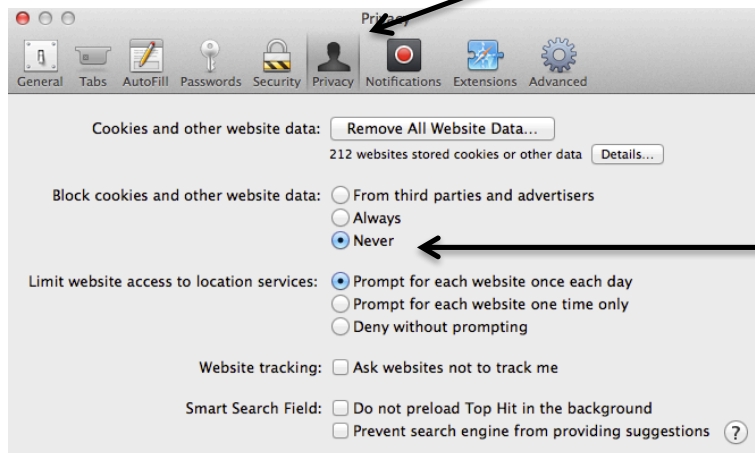
Enabling third party cookies in Safari

To **enable third party cookies in Safari** please follow these steps: Open **Safari** and in the top left corner of your screen click on **Safari** and select Preferences. In the preference window select the Privacy option and under Block **cookies** select Never. Your browser should now accept all **third party cookies**. 1. Click on "Safari". Scroll down to "Preferences" and select.

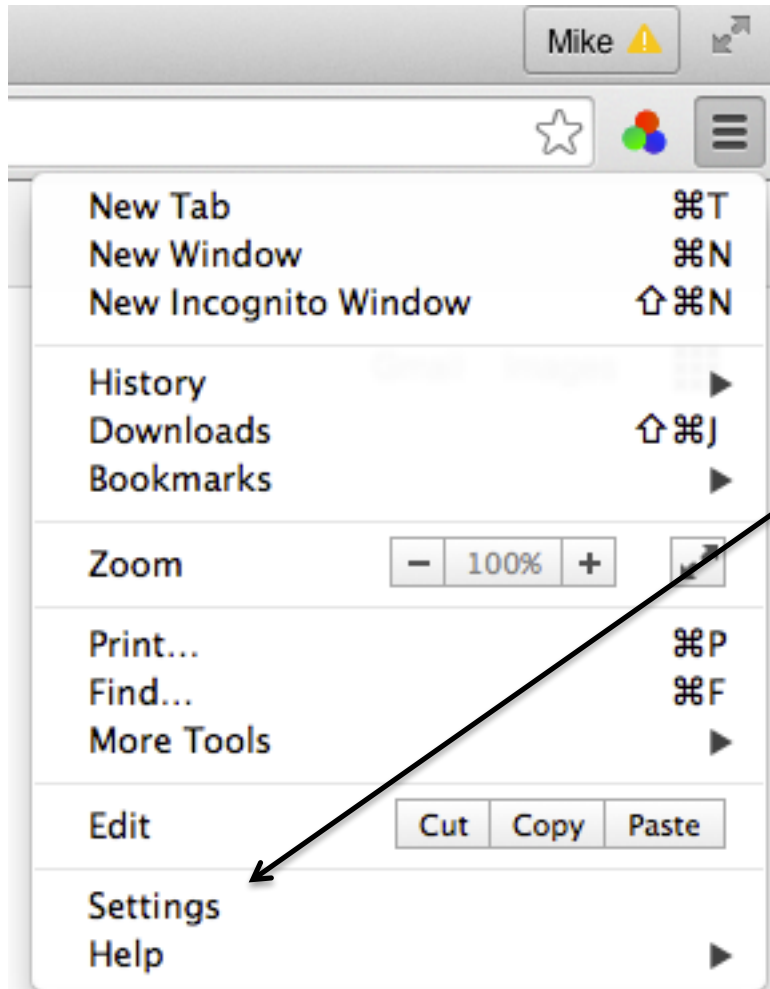
2. Click on "Privacy". Under "Block Cookies...", select "Never". Close the box.



Enabling third party cookies in Chrome

To enable cookies in Google Chrome (Mac and PC):

1. Open Chrome preferences click on Settings, then Show Advanced Settings.
2. Under Privacy, click on Content Settings.
3. Make sure "Block third-party cookies and site data" is not checked.



1. Click on box in upper right corner of Chrome (box with three black lines)
2. Click on "Settings".

3. You may need to click on "Show Advanced Settings" at the bottom of the page to open the full menu.

- Block sites from setting any data
- Block third-party cookies and site data

Enabling third party cookies in Firefox:

To enable cookies in Firefox (PC):

Click the “Tools button in the Firefox menu bar and choose Options. Click Privacy. Look for “Firefox will:” under **History**. Use the pull-down box and set **Firefox will to: Use custom settings for history**. Make sure **Accept cookies** from sites is check marked. Make sure **Accept third party cookies** is set to **Always**. Close that tab. Refresh your browser.

To enable cookies in Firefox (Mac):

1. Click on the word “Firefox” in the toolbar and use the drop-down menu.
2. Select Preferences.
3. Click Privacy.
4. Use the drop-down menu under “**History**” and set "Firefox will" to: Use custom settings for history.
5. Check the box next to "**Accept cookies from sites**" to enable cookies. Make sure “Accept third-party cookies” is set to “Always”.
6. Close that tab. Refresh your browser.
